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President's Recognition Award

This award recognizes a member of the community who has demonstrated considerable efforts in promoting the profession, furthering the mission of the NYSSRC, or other actions that impact on the society that the President deems of significant value to the profession of respiratory care. This award was designed specifically to enable the president to recognize any individual who has significantly contributed to the mission of the NYSSRC. This is not an annual award and more than one award may be given in any calendar year.

GENERAL CRITERIA:

1. The individual must have contributed to the promotion of the profession, the mission of the NYSSRC, or the mission of the AARC.
2. The individual must have advanced the growth of the profession as evidenced by his/her actions.
3. The contributions must not be part of their normal function as a member of the NYSSRC or AARC.

SPECIFIC CRITERIA:

1. This is a discretionary award so no specific criteria are identified.

NOMINATIONS:

1. Nominations must come from an active member of a chapter or NYSSRC Board of Directors (BOD).
2. A Chapter President should write a letter of initial sponsorship and recommendation documenting the contributions and achievements of the nominee.
3. Nominations and letters of support can be submitted to the Awards Committee at any time.
4. All nominations shall be reviewed by the President of the NYSSRC and voted upon by the Awards Committee.
5. The award can be presented at the annual symposium for the chapter submitting the nomination, at the NYSSRC annual symposium, or at any official function of the NYSSRC at the discretion of President and the nominating chapter.
